2023 HARVEST ANTICIPATION & INDUSTRY INSIGHTS

We are excited to share the latest forecast for California's walnut production in 2023, as provided by the California Walnut Commission (CWC) and Board (CWB). The upcoming harvest is projected to yield 790,000 tons, marking a 5% increase from the previous year's production of 752,000 tons. This promising outlook is based on 385,000 bearing acres, slightly down by 4% from 2022.

Robert Verloop, the CEO and Executive Director of CWC and CWB, emphasized the industry's commitment to accuracy in crop information. "The California walnut industry has increased its focus on providing handlers and growers the most accurate crop information by accelerating the collection of various data points," Verloop stated.

As we await the official figures for the 2022 crop year, preliminary data suggests that last year's crop is nearly sold out. Verloop reflected on the challenges faced in 2022, mentioning a significant inventory of 130,000 tons due to the lingering impacts of the COVID-affected global marketplace and an unprecedented September heatwave. However, he expressed optimism for the current crop year, highlighting minimal carryover and favorable weather conditions throughout the growing season.

The anticipated harvest, starting in September and possibly extending into November, aligns with the industry's commitment to aggressive harvesting at peak quality and freshness. Inshell walnut shipments to international destinations are set to commence in October, while retail customers in the U.S. and Canada are actively placing orders, gearing up for their holiday promotions and health-focused kernel campaigns in January and February.

As the industry eagerly anticipates a bountiful harvest, we look forward to witnessing the success of the California walnut community in the 2023 season.
